Whereas, in 2019, New Jersey became the second state to pass a law requiring public schools to incorporate an LGBTQ+-inclusive curriculum into their classrooms; and

Whereas, all children and youth should be able to attend school in a safe and inclusive environment free from discrimination, and civil rights laws contribute to such environments; and

Whereas, the lack of awareness and understanding of issues facing LGBTQ+ children and youth has contributed to higher rates of school dropout, academic failure, and school disengagement; and

Whereas, policies that specifically mention sexual orientation, gender identity and gender expression are associated with: students feeling safer; lower levels of bullying; decreased incidents of harassment related to sexual orientation; increased teacher/staff interventions; and a greater reporting of incidents; and

Whereas, Board Policy 5756 prohibits discrimination in its programs and activities based on sexual orientation, gender Identity, and gender expression among other characteristics; and

Whereas, the rainbow flag, also known as the LGBTQ+ pride flag, serves as a symbol of Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, and Questioning pride and LGBTQ+ social movement; and

Whereas, flying the rainbow flag throughout the month of June further symbolizes the District's celebration of diversity and support for the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender community.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, that Cedar Grove School District recognizes the month of June as LGBTQ+ Pride Month and will begin the implementation of flying the rainbow flag at its buildings during June to inspire equity, create alliances, celebrate diversity, and establish a safe environment in our schools and community; and that this resolution be distributed to every school in the District.
