On June 24, 2015, Christopher D’Amico, Jr. lost his life in a sudden and tragic boating accident on Lake Hopatcong. He had just turned 10 years old a few weeks earlier. Chris was the most loving, kind, and generous boy you would ever meet. He was funny and thoughtful, giving up his own birthday presents to instead donate to an animal shelter.
